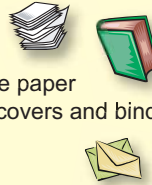
YELLOW BOX FIBERS/PAPER

Hard cover books (covers and bindings removed)



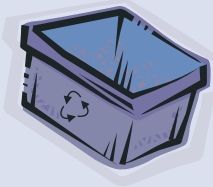
Cardboard Catalogues & magazines

What can I recycle?

PLEASE ENSURE ALL LIQUOR & WINE BOTTLES (GLASS AND/OR PLASTIC), ALUMINUM CANS & TETRA PACKS (SOFT SIDED CONTAINERS) PURCHASED AT THE LCBO ARE RETURNED TO THE BEER STORE FOR A REFUND.



Empty, dry metal paint cans (lids removed)
Empty aerosol cans
Non refundable glass bottles & jars (lids removed)
Cartons (milk, juice, cream)
Drink boxes
Plastic bags: bread, milk, frozen food, dry cleaning & grocery
Aluminum plates & cans
Plastic containers with symbols 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7
(food and beverage containers, household cleaning products, laundry detergent & shampoo bottles)



Styrofoam products (plates, cups, meat trays, egg cartons, packaging)
Steel cans
Cardboard cans (frozen juice, peanuts, hot chocolate)

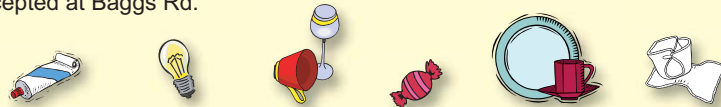

Regular garbage includes window glass, mirrors, ceramic, dishes, diapers, kitty litter, cooking oil/grease, table scraps, toothpaste tubes, furnace filters, chip bags etc. Appliances, mattresses and upholstered furniture, non commercial car and light truck tires with or without rims up to 20 inches in size are also accepted.

Metal waste such as plumbing pipes, metal ceilings, siding, or roofing, reinforcing rods, metal studs, I-beams, stoves, refrigerators and other such appliances; angle iron, heating ductwork and other metal materials are accepted at Baggs Rd.



HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE

PCB-CONTAINING MATERIALS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.
(SOME FEES MAY APPLY CONTACT YOUR MUNICIPAL OFFICE)

Hazardous waste includes: automobile, truck, motorcycle or tractor lead/acid batteries, paint in cans, propane tanks (empty) used motor oil, appliances containing refrigerant (freezers, refrigeration and dehumidifiers) engine antifreeze (ie glycol) fertilizers, pesticides, gasoline, diesel fuel, kerosene, varsol, methanol or other flammable liquids.

MILLER ROAD LANDFILL CONSTRUCTION AND DEMOLITION WASTE

HOURS OF OPERATION

9:00 a.m. to 12 p.m.

Construction and demolition waste is defined as all non-hazardous low metal content waste from construction and demolition clean up projects, consisting primarily of; wood, blocks/stone/bricks, non-metal roofing and siding materials, insulation, waste furniture (does not include mattresses and box springs), window glass, concrete and small amounts of plastic and fiberglass. Permits must be obtained from the Deep River Town Office during their regular business hours. For more information call the Town of Deep River at 613-584-2000.
