The Fire Department had their regular training sessions and meetings in March. There was one response this month which was a dump / bush fire at the Swisha.

EQUIPMENT:

We had problems with the redundant air alarm on one of our breathing apparatuses. The company that was doing the repairs had contacted me to inform me that the parts might not be available. Upon hearing this, I inquired whether this certain part was a part of an upgrade that I was budgeting for this year, and they said no. After a long discussion with a technician, I removed the item from our budget for this year until I could receive more information from the manufacturer. While at the conference in North Bay, I spoke with some manufacturers and suppliers and hopefully we can find enough spare parts to make our apparatus last a few more years. We also got a deal on two sets of bunker gear and a fire nozzle at the conference.
