APRIL 2010 FIRE REPORT

The Fire Department had their regular training sessions and meetings in April. There were two responses this month; a structural fire in Chalk River and one resident burning brush in a barrel.

Equipment:

We have another breathing apparatus with a defective redundant air alarm. I still have had no word on whether there are parts available or not.

We lost four lengths of hose at the Albert Street fire. I have ordered replacements which should be in shortly.

The rear tires on the Chalk River equipment van had to be replaced because of splitting caused by weather.

Events:

The fire fighters ATV poker run was a great success. The weather was perfect and it was the best turnout to date.

On the 22nd, I attended an emergency services meeting in Petawawa. One of the items dealt with was drug grow ops. The guest speaker on the subject was an OPP officer from the Drug Enforcement Unit. It was suggested that we try to have the presentation made for the new Councils, Chief Building Officials and Fire Officers of North Renfrew in the early part of the new-year. If this goes ahead, it will probably be held in Petawawa because of the large number of participants that could participate.
