## **Public Works Report – May 2010**

### **Roads**

- Patching all roads where needed
- Changing rotten and damaged culverts that were all noticed during the fall culvert inspection / inventory count
- Picking up garbage from roadways
- Grading of all roads that were in need
- Green Wood Paving has started the rehabilitation of Gutzman Road. They are off to a good start and are expected to be finished sometime in mid June

### **Equipment**

- Regular maintenance of equipment
- Two mechanics from Strongco (Champion dealer in Ottawa) came to the Public Works building for three days and two of our guys assisted in the repairs which cut down on the labour cost
- Owner and founder from AMI attachments (cold patch / shouldering box) was at our shop to assist in the installation of the new box. It was installed but needs a few more items done to make it complete and workable

### **Recreation & Buildings**

- Interviewed for the summer student position and hired two students
- Regular maintenance on all mowers and lawn equipment
- Went over all safety precautions and procedures with students
- Grass cutting, and garbage clean up
- Water sprinkler system for the Chalk River ball and soccer fields has been tested and is up and running
- Painted the rear wall of the Chalk River rink building to cover up graffiti that was painted over the entire wall

### **Other**

- The Public Works Superintendent attended TJ Mahony Road school (Construction section) for 3 days in Guelph
- All gravel crushing for road repairs and maintenance is completed
- One of the two fish carvings in Chalk River ( corner of Main St. and Railway St.) was broken off and destroyed
- One of the two gates at the gravel pit on Leaders Road was stolen. We have purchased a new gate and installed it. The Police were notified and they are going to patrol this area more often.
- River's Painting installed new fence at 102 Ratton in Mountain View Subdivision. This was due to limbs falling of the large tree near his property
- Swept the forestry roadway for the Petawawa Resource Centre

### **June Work**

- Graveling and raising common flooding areas as required
- Calcium put on all gravel roads
- Graveling on roads
- Ball and soccer field maintenance to be completed first week of June
- Put in raft at Burkes Beach
- Replacing and installing new culverts
- Ditching
