Public Works Report – June 2010

Roads

- Changing / adding new culverts where needed for proper road drainage
- Raising low wet areas of the of gravel roadways where needed
- Gutzman Road is completed with new surface treatment, culverts and proper road shaping
- Fields Road is complete with proper grading and double surface treatment
- Mill Yard Road, Blimkie and Violet Street are prepped for new surface treatment. We are currently doing some ditching and waiting for water service to be put across the road
- Using the brusher on all roadways while we still have the unit installed in the loader.
- Patching of all roadways in need
- Two loads of calcium are down, the third load will be down within the week (weather permitting)

Equipment

- Repaired front hub bearing and u-joint on 01 Dodge half ton
- Replaced leaking steering box seals on the Ford half ton
- Replaced blown hydraulic lines on JD Loader and Brusher unit

Recreation & Buildings

- Mountain View Turf performed annual maintenance on ball / soccer fields in Chalk River
- Chalk River rink building had the roof replaced, old chimney removed and the soffit and fascia repaired
- Repaired outside lights on FEN Center building
- Put raft in at Burkes Beach and placed the shelter base on beach. The roof will be rebuilt and will take place at a later date due to last years inconvenience
- Students cleaning and doing maintenance of lawn equipment

Other

- Patrolling and controlling water flow from Black Duck Lake when necessary
- One of our light standards at Ottawa St. and Highway 17 was destroyed when a vehicle lost control on the Highway. The pole and light have been replaced and are working again
- The Public Works Superintendent attended a meeting that was recently developed for Road Superintendents to discuss common problems and concerns. These meeting will continue 4 times a year and are very informative and helpful
- Walking / monitoring creek ways that exit Black Duck Lake and removing any obstructions
- The third and final “Laurentian Hills” sign has been installed
